Location: Iraq, Kurdistan Region, Erbil (Sorani & Khalifan Districts)

Summary of Achievements

Project Overview

- **Food Aid:** 50 Comprehensive Food Baskets.
- **Financial Support:** 64 Cash Envelopes (Distributed based on family needs).
- **Total Families Assisted:** 114 Households in Sorani & Khalifan.

Project Implementation Methodology

The Zakat Al-Fitr 2026 project was implemented through a field assessment conducted by the HHRO team to identify the most vulnerable families in the Sorani and Khalifan regions.

- **Selection Criteria:** Priorities were given to widows, orphans, and households with no fixed income.
- **Cash Grant System:** Financial aid was categorized into five tiers (100k, 140k, 150k, 200k, and 300k IQD) based on family size and urgent living requirements.
- **Direct Handover:** To ensure transparency and dignity, all food baskets and cash grants were delivered directly to the heads of households.

Total Families: 114 Households

The total distribution included 64 cash envelopes and 50 food baskets, reaching a total of 114 vulnerable households. The total financial aid distributed amounted to 12,950,000 IQD, alongside the essential food items. This allocation was carefully managed by the HHRO field team to ensure maximum impact for the most vulnerable families in Soran and Khalifan.

Project Impact:

- Provided immediate food security for 50 families for the Eid period and the weeks following.
- Enabled 64 families to cover essential Eid expenses and urgent household needs through direct cash support.
